

School Uniform Policy
CJD International School Braunschweig-Wolfsburg
Primary to Senior School

Preliminary Notes

At CJD International School, students wear school uniforms to promote a sense of belonging, unity, and school pride. Our school uniform contributes to offering a safe and comfortable learning environment and is considered a reflection of the school's value system. Our school uniform allows a neat and orderly appearance appropriate to the school, and students avoid competition in dress.

Our school uniform consists of several pieces with the CJD International School logo on the front. Our school uniform provider, Dress For School: <https://cjd-braunschweig.dress-for-school.de/> offers a wide selection of items.

General Rules

Students at the International School are required to wear the official school uniform to school and all school-related activities (e.g. school parties, day trips, etc.).

Students must arrive and leave in uniform every day. Coordinators will send home students without their school uniform.

The top and bottom of the uniform must meet. (This means no bare midriffs and no sagging jeans!)

Waistbands must be worn at the waist.

Undergarments are not permitted to be visible in any way.

Clothing should not have any tears or rips.

Uniforms may not be defaced in any way.

No items or clothing that refer to tobacco, alcohol, drugs, abusive language, racism or sexual connotations are allowed. Any cleavage is strictly forbidden.

Coordinators of the sections can grant Casual Fridays. These are days when students can wear their private clothes, considering the regulations of the School Uniform Policy.

Staff members check that students wear the school uniform as described in these regulations.

Tops

The school logo must always be visible on the upper part of the uniform.

Non-uniform hoodies, fleece, sweaters, jumpers, or sweatshirts are not allowed at school. Tops not part of the uniform are not allowed to show under, over, through, or around the edges of the uniform. Students need to zip up /button up their uniform jacket or cardigan for this purpose.

Bottoms

Skirts and shorts must not exceed a hand's width above the knees.

All private jeans or skirts must be the same navy (dark blue) or black colour as the school uniform and may not have any fading, light patches, discolouration, adornments, or logos visible on them. Leggings may be worn only under shorts, skirts, or dresses in the official uniform and must be white or navy blue.

Leggings only and sports or jogging pants are not appropriate for school.

Outerwear

All outdoor clothing (jackets, coats, etc.) should be removed when students enter the school buildings.

Students can wear coats and winter wear on the school premises. If the temperature is extremely low, teachers may grant permission in the Entrance Hall or classrooms.

Sports Uniform

For sports classes and sports functions, the uniform consists of an official white school uniform t-shirt with the school logo, and any dark blue or navy athletic shorts or bottoms.

Jeans are not permitted in the sports lesson. Students may also wear the colour of their House instead of the white T-shirt. Only light-soled athletic shoes are permitted in the school gym.

Other

Hats, hoods or head coverings are not to be worn inside the buildings at any time except for religious reasons.

Scarves, belts, or other permitted accessories must be plain neutral colours that do not detract from the uniform.

Loud or oversized jewellery is not allowed.

Flip flops are not permitted for safety reasons on the entire school premises.

House shoes/ slippers are only allowed to be worn inside the classrooms and only in the Early Years and Primary sections.

Ordering School Uniform

Ordering school uniforms is quick and convenient with the school uniform provider Dress For School (<https://cjd-braunschweig.dress-for-school.de/>). Students can choose their favourite items from a selection of articles. Families should consider ordering enough pieces appropriate for the different seasons in Germany.

Families can order all items online. The delivery time is about one week from receipt of order. Should an item be out of stock, families will be informed immediately.
