CJD Christophorus Grammar School

Our Grammar School is located near the centre of Braunschweig. We are characterised by our many offers for students interested in mathematics and science and a warm school community.

From Year 5 to 13, the students become increasingly independent in their work. In the sixth form, students can choose from many courses to cover a broad spectrum of their interests. For very hard-working and talented students, there are even competence and excellence courses. These go beyond the prescribed school curriculum. There is close cooperation with many colleges and universities in Braunschweig and the surrounding area. At the end of Year 13 students take four written and one oral examination.

The language of instruction is German. In Year 10, students will need a B2 language certificate to follow the class discussion. From Year 11 onwards, the C1 certificate is expected. You can enter this grade with an extended secondary level I qualification or a comparable foreign qualification.

Students who successfully pass the examinations are awarded the German Abitur. This entitles them to enter university anywhere in Germany.




Who are we?
